An Acr relative to the School Fund for Montgomery County, and for the Education of Poor Children in said County .- 1825, ch. 181. This act merges the prior local acts.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, Commis-That Ephraim Gaither, Richard H. Griffith, James Day, Baker spointed. Waters, William Brewer, Elisha W. Williams, Thomas P. Willson, Otho Magruder, Roger Brook and Thomas Gettings. be, and they are hereby constituted and appointed commissioners for the purpose of applying and distributing the school fund appropriated for the education of the poor children, or for free schools in Montgomery county, as herein after directed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted. That the orphans court for the Orphans county aforesaid, shall have power, and it shall be the duty of court to fill vacancies. said court to fill up all vacancies that may occur in the aforesaid board or list of commissioners, let the said vacancies happen from what cause soever they may; and the appointments so to be made, shall always be made from the election district in which the vacancy may happen, so that the number of two commissioners may always be kept up in each district.

SEC. 3.
