poor children. coming within the meaning of this act, and who as such are entitled to the benefits of said act, adopting some general rule by which to be governed in all decisions upon this point.

Change the rate of tuition.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That the board of commissioners shall have power to change the rate of tuition at any of their annual meetings, seven members of said board concurring therein.

Account annually.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of the board of commissioners to keep a register of their proceeding and expenditures, and to return an account of the same annually, between the second Monday of December, and the second Monday of February, in each and every year, to the treasurer of the western shore.

Extra meetings. SEC. 14. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act contained shall be contrued to prevent the commissioners appointed in virtue of this act, from meeting quarter yearly, or as often as they may think it necessary, or to prevent their meeting at any place they may think proper, with a view of carrying into effect the provisions of this act, or any of them; Provided, that said commissioners shall receive no compensation for attendance, except at yearly meetings, as herein before provided for.

Acts inconsistent herewith repealed. SEC. 15. And be it enacted, That all former acts or parts of acts, or resolutions, inconsistent with or repugnant to the provisions of this act, or any of them, be and they are hereby repealed.

Annual dividends to be distributed, &c.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the levy court of Montgomery county be, and they are hereby authorized and directed, to distribute the annual dividends due from the bank stocks, hitherto invested as the free school fund of Montgomery county, and their annual incoming portion of the fund, in due proportions to the white population of each election district in said county, and that they meet on
