SEC. 23. And be it enacted, That the said managers shall, Powers and each acting in his respective district, examine all teachers, and duties of managers. dismiss any intemperate, cruel, negligent, or immoral teachers, at the end of any month, adopt and cause to be put up in every school-house, a general system of rules and regulations, direct what books shall be used, and what branches shall be taught, visit every school at least once a year, suspend or dismiss all pupils found guilty of incorrigibly bad conduct, establish primary schools for female white children exclusively, where the same shall be requested or recommended by the trustees of any sub-district, exercise a general supervision and endeavour to promote the full, equal and useful instruction of the youth of said county.

SEC. 24. And be it enacted, That the said managers, each Draft and acting for his respective district, shall draw and pay over to pay over to school the said trustees for distribution, all moneys coming or pro-moneys. perly belonging to his said district, and payment shall be made in all cases, by an order or draft, upon the treasurer of the school fund of Montgomery county, signed by said manager.

SEC. 25. And be it enacted, That no commissioner, mana- Teachers ger, trustee, or clerk, during his continuance in office, shall be excluded. a teacher or contractor for building a school-house, or do any other work about the same, for which he shall charge compensation.

SEC. 26. And be it enacted, That if the whole, or any por- Case of tion of the moneys due, or apportioned to any district, shall expended. not be applied, in consequence of the temporary suspension of any school, or from any other cause, such moneys shall remain in the hands of the treasurer of the school fund of Montgomery county, or having been drawn by a manager on the trustees of any school district, shall be held as a special trust special for the benefit of the school, or schools, for which it was originally apportioned, or drawn, as aforesaid.
