

**SEC. 13.** *And be it enacted,* That in case of a failure to elect a commissioner in any of the said districts, by reason of a tie, it shall be the duty of the sheriff of Saint Mary's county upon receiving official information of the fact from the clerk of said county, to appoint a day for holding a new election for commissioner from said district, upon at least ten day's notice, exclusive of the day of holding such election; and the judges of election for said election district, shall hold the same, under the regulations herein before provided, for the regular election of commissioners for said county, and make their returns in the same manner.

**SEC. 1.** *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, the justices of the levy court of Saint Mary's county, be, and they are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed, at their next meeting, and from time to time thereafter as in their judgment they may think fit, to establish and regulate the rates of all public inns and taverns in Saint Mary's county.
