WHEREAS, great inconvenience and public injury have Preamble. arisen from the mode at present provided by law for the collection of fines for neglect to work on the public roads; there-

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Recovery from and after the passage of this act, all overseeers of roads shall, as soon as fines are incurred for neglect to work on the public roads, call upon each and every person liable to a fine or fines, and demand the payment of the sum forfeited, and on refusal or neglect to pay the same, the overseer shall proceed to recover the same before a single justice of the peace, by due course of law, as is now provided in the act to which this is a supplement.
