SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners elected or appointed as aforesaid, and their successors, shall be, and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title of the commissioners of Worcester county, and by that name shall have continued and perpetual succession, and be capable in law of suing and being sued, of making and using a corporate seal, and of altering the same; of taking holding, selling and conveying all kinds of estates, property and effects, and of doing all such acts as shall be necessary to the exercise of all powers which are or shall be vested in them by this act, or by *another** act of assembly, as fully and effectually as corporate bodies may or can lawfully and rightfully do.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That when, and as soon as the commissioners to be elected or appointed as aforesaid, shall have taken and subscribed the oath or affirmation herein before described, all the powers, rights and privileges lawfully exercised by, and all property, estate and effects vested in the justices of the levy court of Worcester county, shall be transferred to, and vested in the commissioners for Worcester county, who, or any three of them, shall thereafter exercise all the powers, rights and privileges, and shall perform all the duties required to be performed by the said justices of the levy court for Worcester county, and no appointment of justices of the levy court for Worcester county shall thereafter be made, and all the powers lawfully exercised by, or vested in the commissioners of the tax for Worcester county, and all the duties required by law to be performed by them, shall be vested in and exercised and performed by the said commissioners for Worcester county, after they shall have become qualified as aforesaid.

Powers, rights and duties of the levy court transferred to them.

And of commissioners of tax.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the said county commissioners shall take such appeals, and note such transfers as the commissioners of the tax are now required to take and note, at any of their meetings between the first day of May and the last day of the same month, and for the purpose of taking such appeals and noting such transfers, shall meet every day during the first week of the spring term of the county court, and shall give notice in writing, to be set up in some public place in each election district, ten days before the commencement of said term, of the meetings to be held for that purpose; and also that the said county commissioners, at their said meetings, shall, in their own discretion, transact any other business which, as county commissioners, they may of right do under this act.
