

the Wednesday after the first Monday in June, annually, and that all the other meetings of the said trustees, under the act, entitled, an act for the relief of the poor of the several counties of this state, and the several supplements thereto, shall be subject to the appointment of the said trustees.

Badge. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That from and after the passage of this act, the said trustees, or the said overseer of the poor of Worcester county, may at their discretion, use the badge described in the tenth section of the act, entitled, an act for the relief of the poor of the several counties of this state, in the manner prescribed by the said tenth section of the said act.

AN ACT to repeal the twelfth and thirteenth sections of an Act for the relief of the Poor of Worcester County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, chapter one hundred and fifty-four. 1824, ch. 72.

Repeal. SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the twelfth and thirteenth sections of an act, entitled, an act for the relief of the poor of Worcester county, being supplementary to the act, entitled, an act for the relief of the poor of the several counties of this state, be, and the same are hereby repealed, so far as they relate to the selling the poor-house lands, and the purchasing of other lands for a poor-house in said county, and also so far as it relates to the levying and collecting money for the purpose aforesaid.

Acceptance required. SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That this act shall not take effect or be in force until the trustees of the poor of Worcester county shall enter their acceptance of the same on their journals or minutes of proceedings.
