PUBLIC GENERAL LAWS

Passed at December Session, 1839.

An Acr, entitled, a Supplement to the several Acts of Assembly passed for the benefit of Insolvent Debtors.—1839, ch. 10.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Judges of the judges of the several county courts within the state of county to Maryland, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered grant relief to grant unto all persons whatever, the benefit of the several solvent acts of assembly passed for the relief of insolvent debtors; laws to all Provided, the said persons shall in all respects, comply with sixty days the requisitions of the said acts of assembly, except proof of residence. residence of two years, proof of residence of sixty days to be sufficient, and that they satisfy the judges of the several county courts aforesaid, that they did not come into this state with the view and for the purpose of obtaining the benefit of the said insolvent laws; And provided, the aforesaid persons shall be Proviso. compelled to file their petitions for the benefit of the said insolvent laws, in the usual manner, with a justice of the orphans court of the county, who is hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary orders, and discharge them from actual Not to apcustody on the usual terms; Provided nevertheless, that no ply to Baltimore city part of this act shall be so construed as to apply to the city or county. or county of Baltimore.
