BROKERS.

Declared unlawful for any president, director, &c. of a bank, to employ a broker, &c. for the purpose of dealing in buying, and selling or exchanging any bank notes for less than the nominal value—1818, ch. 191, sec. 1,	698
No person, or body politic to be engaged in such business, and the penalty therefor—1818, ch. 191, sec. 2,	698
Nor to buy gold or silver coin with notes for a greater sum than their nominal value, and the penalty therefor—1818, ch. 191, sec. 3, . . .	698
Banks not to dispose of any gold or silver coin for a price more than the standard value thereof—1818, ch. 191, sec. 4,	793
Penalty on persons receiving from any bank any gold or silver with intent to sell the same, or to obtain a premium therefor—1818, ch. 191, sec. 5,	793
The two preceding sections so far as same relates to the sale or disposition of foreign or silver coin repealed—1823, ch. 147, sec. 1, . . .	793
