

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said judge of the orphans court in the execution of this act, shall have and exercise all the powers which are had and exercised by any judge of a county court under the original act, and the several supplements thereto.

Who are vested with same power as judges of county courts.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That all proceedings to be had by any judge of the orphans court under this act, shall be by him lodged with the clerk of the county court, within thirty days thereafter, and the judges of the court shall proceed thereon according to the provisions of the original act, and the several supplements thereto.

Proceedings to be lodged with clerk.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the act of assembly, entitled, an act for the relief of insolvent debtors, passed in the year seventeen hundred and seventy-four,* be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said judge of the orphans court shall be entitled to the sum of one dollar as a compensation for his trouble, to be paid by the said debtor.

Compensation.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be held to repeal, alter or change, an act,† entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors in the city and county of Baltimore.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That in all cases where application hath been or shall hereafter be made to any judge of the county or orphans court, for the benefit of the act to which this is a supplement, the petition shall not be dismissed by the county court before the time appointed for the hearing of such application by the judge to whom the same hath been or shall be made.

Applications not be dismissed.

CHAPTER 198.

AN ACT to continue in force the Acts of Assembly which would expire with the present session.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all such acts, and parts of acts of assembly, as would expire with the present session, except an act, entitled, an act for the temporary relief of the poor in the several counties in this state, passed December session eighteen hundred and sixteen,* be and the same are hereby continued until the twentieth day of November next, and until the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter.
