CHAPTER 48.

An Acr for the Relief of the Sheriffs and Collectors of the several Counties in this State.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, County That in all cases where the sheriffs and collectors of the tax courts may of the several counties in this state, have heretofore failed, or further time shall hereafter fail to collect moneys which they are authorized for completing coland directed to collect, in the time limited by law, that such lections. sheriffs and collectors, their executors or administrators, may apply, by petition in writing, to the judges of the county courts of their respective counties, and the judges, by an order made on such petition, shall have power, in their discretion, to limit and appoint such further time to complete the collections of the sheriffs or collectors; and the court shall have power, from time to time, in manner aforesaid, to extend the time of collection by the said sheriffs or collectors; and it shall be the duty of the clerk of the county court, where such petition is filed, to record the proceedings aforesaid, for which he shall receive from the persons filing the petition, such fees as he receives for recording deeds.
