CHAPTER 246.

AN ACT, entitled, a SUPPLEMENT to the ACT,\* laying duties on licenses to \* 1819, ch. 184.  
retailers of Dry Goods and for other purposes.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Repeal.  
That so much of the fifth section of the original act to which this is a supplement, as excepts a person obtaining a license for retailing of wine, rum, brandy, whiskey or other distilled spirituous liquors from taking out a license for retailing of dry goods as provided by the said law, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 250.

A further SUPPLEMENT to the ACT, entitled, an Act relating to Insolvent Debtors in the city and county of Baltimore.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Petitioners  
That in all cases of applications for the benefit of the insolvent not

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That in all cases in which such May  
failure may have heretofore taken place, (provided the said com- prosecute.  
missioners or Baltimore county court shall be satisfied it did not arise from a fraudulent design on the part of the petitioner,) the said petitioner shall be and he is hereby authorized to prosecute a new petition for the benefit of said insolvent laws.
