

## CHAPTER 172.

An additional SUPPLEMENT to the ACT,\* entitled, an Act for the speedy \*1791, ch  
recovery of Small Debts out of Court, and to repeal the acts of assembly 68.  
therein mentioned.

*Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Case of ap  
peals from  
magistrate  
judgments  
upon all appeals hereafter prosecuted to the several county  
courts of this state, from the judgment of a justice of the peace,  
it shall be the duty of the judges of the several county courts,  
to give judgment according to the very right of the cause and  
the law of the land, without regarding any omission or defect in  
the proceedings of the said justice of the peace, and no judg-  
ment so as aforesaid appealed from shall be reversed or set aside  
for any imperfection, omission, or defect in the proceedings of  
said justice of peace, in and relating to the judgment so as  
aforesaid appealed from.

## CHAPTER 176.

An additional SUPPLEMENT to the ACT,\* entitled, an Act to establish Pilots, \* 1803, ch.  
and regulate their fees, made and passed by the General Assembly of 63.  
the State of Maryland, at their November session, eighteen hundred and  
three.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland,* Rate.  
That from and after the first day of March next, it shall not be  
lawful for any pilot to charge or receive any greater reward or  
compensation for his services, than is herein after expressed, to  
wit: for every vessel from sea to Baltimore city, three dollars  
and fifty cents, and from said city of Baltimore to sea, two dol-  
lars fifty cents, except in the months of December, January and  
February, when they shall receive seventy-five cents in addi-  
tion for each and every foot of water she shall draw; and from  
the mouth of Potomac to Georgetown, and vice versa, there  
shall be an addition of one-fifth to the above rates, and so in  
proportion for any less distance from any other port of this state  
to sea, or from sea to any other port of this state, such distance  
to be fixed by the said board of examiners, but no pilot shall  
receive any reward or pay for any supernumerary inches under  
six, any thing in any other act or law to the contrary notwith-  
standing.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That an act, entitled, a further Repeal.  
supplement to the act, entitled, an act to establish pilots and  
regulate their fees, passed by the general assembly of the state  
of Maryland, the seventeenth of February, eighteen hundred  
and nineteen, be, and the same is hereby repealed.
