

SEC. 22. *And be it enacted*, That the compensation of the commissioners of lotteries and their clerk, shall be dependent upon and be received out of the funds derived from the avails of lotteries drawn or to be drawn during the current year.

## CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT to exempt the Wearing Apparel of Deceased Persons from Appraisement and exposure to Sale by Executors and Administrators. Repealed by 1830, ch. 617.

## CHAPTER 148.

A SUPPLEMENT to the ACT, entitled, an Act to regulate Sales by Public Auctions, passed at December session, 1827. Transferred to 'Public Local Law,' title, 'Baltimore City.'

## CHAPTER 160.

AN ACT SUPPLEMENTARY to an ACT, entitled, an Act to regulate Elections.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, at all elections of delegates to the general assembly, elections of electors of the senate, electors of president and vice-president of the United States, of representatives in congress, and of sheriffs, it shall be lawful for any justice of the peace for the respective county in which such election is held, to qualify the judges of such respective election, and their clerks, and the oaths administered by such justice shall be as valid as if administered in the manner heretofore prescribed by law.

## CHAPTER 164.

A further additional SUPPLEMENT to an ACT\* to regulate the Inspection of Tobacco. \*1801, ch. 63.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That hereafter no tobacco shall be passed, or accounted lawful tobacco, unless the same shall be packed in hogsheads not exceeding fifty inches in the length of the staves, and seventy-six inches in the whole diameter within the staves, at the cross and bilge, and the owner of tobacco packed in any hogshead of greater dimensions shall repack the same in sizeable hogsheads as herein before expressed and directed, at his own expense, before the same shall be passed.

Size of hogsheads regulated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That no inspector or inspectors of tobacco in this state shall require any owner or owners of tobacco, heretofore packed in hogsheads varying from the dimensions required by the act of assembly passed at November session 1801, chapter 63, section 125, to repack the same in hogsheads of the dimensions required by said act, before the first day of December next, any law to the contrary hereof notwithstanding.

Inspectors not to require owners in certain cases to repack tobacco.
