Section 10, line 5, after the word "line," insert the words at a point distant from Williamsport not more than twenty-five miles.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Silver submitted the following amendment:

Section 21, line 4, strike out the word "modify," and insert the word appeal.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Bowlus submitted the following amendment:

Strike out sections 22, 23 and 24.

Which was adopted.

The bill as amended was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
