Which was adopted.

The order as amended, was then adopted.

Mr. Silver submitted the following order:

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal, that John S. Brown was not in his seat yesterday, owing to extreme illness in his family;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Keech submitted the following order:

Ordered, That it be entered on the Journal, that Benjamin Silver, a member of this House, was not in his seat on yesterday, on account of inability to reach this city in time;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Jordan submitted the following order:

Ordered, That it be placed on the Journal of this House, that Mr. John W. Harden, is absent from this House on account of ill health;
