stitutions amounting to \$11,500, ordered by the General Assembly is included in the \$48,500.

Your Committee respectfully recommend the ratification of the proposed contract. It may not be out of place to say, that the State will save \$20,000, in the expenditure of printing as compared with the last session of the Legislature. It may be well to remark that all the members of the Committee were present, and the vote was unanimous for the above contract.
