The question then recurring upon the adoption of the title,

Mr. Williams submitted the following amendment :

Strike out all after the word 'to' in first line, and insert, add new sections to the Code of Public Local Laws for Baltimore city, Article 4, under the head of Tobacco, as amended and re-amended by the Acts of Assembly of 1864, chapter 346 ; 1865, chapter 194 ; and 1867, chapter 360.
