Amendments proposed :

Section 1, line 18, strike out all after the word 'dollars' to the word 'for' in the 20th line.

Which was adopted.

Section 1, line 18, after the word 'dollars' insert as follows: To St. Agnes' Hospital, the sum of three thousand dollars; to Children's Aid Society of Baltimore City, five hundred dollars; the Baltimore Orphan Asylum, two thousand dollars; to St. Mary's Industrial School, ten thousand dollars.
