Also,

The following House bills, endorsed "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Corporations, and report adopted."

A bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act entitled a further supplement to an Act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county and for other purposes, passed 20th day of March, 1865, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act amendatory of an Act passed February 13, 1862, and entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore City Passenger Railway Company.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal chapter 153, passed January session, 1867, entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 30 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Crimes and Punishments, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Being upon a third reading,

On motion of Mr. Slingluff,

Said bill was indefinitely postponed.

Mr. Latrobe, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means, reported favorably

The Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit the collectors of city and county taxes from applying money collected by them for city and county purposes to the payment of State taxes.

Which was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The hour of 2½ o'clock, P. M. having arrived,

The House took a recess until 4½ o'clock, P. M.
