A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Monumental Permanent Building and Land Society of Baltimore.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to confer upon the Lochiel Lumber, Mining, Manufacturing and Improvement Company of Allegany county, the authority to erect and maintain a boom or booms, with piers and necessary appurtenances upon the Great Savage river, in Allegany county.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Havre-de-Grace Ferry Company.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 151, 152, 153 and 154 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Coroners and Inquests in the city of Baltimore, and to substitute therefor the following.

Also,

The bill entitled an Act to add new sections to the Code of Public Local Laws for Baltimore city, Article 4, under the head of Tobacco, as amended by the Act of Assembly of 1864, chapter 346, 1865, chapter 194, and 1867, chapter 368.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Howard county to subscribe to the capital stock of Turnpike roads in said county.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Mechanics Loan and Savings Institute of Clearspring, Md.

The bill entitled an Act to add a new section to Article 10 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled Attachments, to come in after section 44, of said Article, giving jurisdiction to Justices of the Peace to issue attachments in certain cases.
