Leave was granted and referred to Committee on Corporations to report a bill to repeal an Act, entitled an Act, to incorporate a company to construct a turnpike road from Hagerstown to Cearfoss' cross roads, in Washington county, passed March, 1860, chapter 298, and re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion by Mr. Malone,

Leave was granted, and referred to Senators from Wicomico, Worcester and Somerset, to report a bill, regulating the Terms of the Circuit Court for Wicomico county.
