Mr. Parker, of Worcester, from the select committee, reported Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at or near New Ark, in Worcester county, in the State of Maryland.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Malone, from select committee, reported Senate bill entitled an Act regulating the number, and prescribing the powers and duties of the County Commissioners for Wicomico county.

Which was read the first time.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered House bill, Endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays,"

Entitled an Act to amend and re-enact section 805 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the city of Baltimore, under the sub-title "Orphans' Court."

Which was read the first time.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to levy and refund a certain sum of money to Samuel Redgraves, for county and school taxes erroneously paid by him.

Endorsed passed by yeas and nays.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

Also, House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Continental Fire and Marine Insurance Company of Baltimore.

Endorsed "Passed by yeas and nays."
