Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

The joint resolution in relation to naturalized citizens,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed.

Senate bill entitled an Act providing for the issue of execution on judgments in Somerset and Worcester counties against persons residing in Wicomico county,

Was read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays asfollows:
