Came up for a second reading.

The Sergeant-at-Arms was sent to notify the absent Senators.

On motion by Mr. Malone,

Further proceedings under the call were dispensed with,

And the bill was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Western Run and Reisterstown Turnpike Company,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to Lewis Tydings and Henry Tydings, of Anne Arundel county, certain sums of money erroneously paid into the Treasury,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
