Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Finance.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal the 39th section of Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Montgomery County," relating to the number of Justices of the Peace and Constables, and re-enacting the same so as to read as follows:

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the repayment out of the storage and outage on tobacco of moneys heretofore demanded and received by the Inspectors of Tobacco, in violation of the Acts of 1864, chapter 346, and 1865, chapter 194, and to repeal the Act of 1867, chapter 148, in relation to that subject.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to the Code of Public General Laws, Article 69, entitled "Officers."
