

On motion by Mr. Malone,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to report a bill appointing seven commissioners who shall be authorized and empowered to purchase a site, and to erect thereon a Court House and jail in the town of Salisbury for Wicomico county.

Mr. Clarke presented the petition of Joseph Trainer and eight other public school teachers of Baltimore city.

Which was referred to the Committee on Education.

Mr. Grove, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported favorably House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 69, of Article first, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title, Allegany county, sub-title Fences, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the second time.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal the Act of 1867, chapter 235, entitled an Act to repeal section 39 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the County Commissioners for Somerset county, and to re-enact the said section 39 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to Somerset county, so as to read as follows.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal the 39th section of Article 15 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Montgomery County," relating to the number of Justices of the Peace and Constables, and re-enacting the same so as to read as follows.

Mr. Brewer moved to suspend the rules in order to give the bill a third reading.
