

Strike out all after the word "say" in the fourth line of the first section, and insert, "each member of the General Assembly shall be allowed as mileage, twenty cents per mile, for the distance he may have to travel to and from Annapolis city, such distance in every instance to be estimated from the Post Office nearest the residence of each member, and the Committee on Claims for the House of Delegates shall have full power to estimate and adjust said mileage as herein directed.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Clarke submitted the following amendment:

Amend section one by inserting after the word cents, no member shall receive more than ten cents per mile as mileage, the distance to be computed from the county seat.
