House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 194, of Article 8, of the Public Local Laws, entitled Anne Arundel county, sub-title Sheriff, and to re-enact another section in lieu thereof, relating to the fees of Sheriff for keeping and boarding prisoners.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Southern Maryland Rail Road Company,

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
