A bill entitled an Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws, to be entitled Foreign Insurance, to provide for the appointment of a superintendent of Foreign Insurance, and for licensing Foreign Insurance Companies carrying on the business in this State of Fire Insurance, Marine Insurance, Inland Navigation Insurance, Life Insurance, Accident Insurance, Health Insurance and all other kinds of insurance of every description, and for taxing for State and municipal purposes, the revenues accruing from such insurance business done in this State by all insurance companies not incorporated by the laws of this State, and for the repeal of sections 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36, of the 56th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, sub-title Foreign Insurance and Companies.
