Senate bill entitled an Act to release to Wm. Watson, Emily Watson and Thomas Watson, all the rights and interest of the State of Maryland, in and to the personal estate of Michael M. Mitchell, late of Baltimore county, deceased.

With the following amendments:

Amend 1st line, by striking out the words "Emily Watson and Thomas Watson."

In 6th line, strike out the words "and Thomas Watson, his stepson."

In the 10th line, strike out the words "and whereas the said Thomas Watson, hath departed this life since the death of said Michael M. Mitchell, leaving Emily Watson, his widow, and Thomas Watson his only son and personal representative.

In the 15th line, strike out the words "and whereas the said William Watson and the said Emily and Thomas Watson, the widow and representative of said Thomas Watson, deceased, are in needy circumstances.

In the 3rd line, 1st section, strike out the words "Emily Watson and Thomas Watson."

In the 4th line, 1st section, strike out the word "they," and insert "he."

In the 5th line, 1st section, strike out the words "and in the same proportions," in the same line insert the word "he," in the same line, strike out the words "and Thomas Watson, deceased."

In the 6th line, strike out the word "children," and insert "child."
