House bill entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick to subscribe to the capital stock of the Frederick and Pennsylvania Line Rail Road Company, and to endorse the bonds of said company.

Returned Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate a company to construct a turnpike road from Hagerstown to Cearfoss' Cross Roads, in Washington county,

With proposed amendments.

Additional section as section 9:

*And be it enacted,* That this Company shall not be privileged to charge tolls on any vehicle passing over the road for the purpose of attending funerals.
