

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Dorchester county to levy a sum of money on the taxable property of said county to refund to the executors of Thomas Woolford, deceased, taxes paid in error,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 23 of the 1st Article of the Code of Public Local Laws, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Was read a third time and passed by yeas and nays as follows :
