

8 of an Act passed January session, 1864, chapter 15, entitled an Act to aid and encourage enlistments into the Maryland regiments in the service of the United States, and also to repeal sections 4 and 5 of an Act passed January session, 1865, chapter 33, entitled an Act to provide bounty for soldiers entering the service of the United States to fill the quota of Maryland, under the call of the President of the United States of December, 1864, and under future calls.

Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the Comptroller of the Treasury to adjust and settle the accounts due by Collectors, Sheriffs, Clerks, Registers and other receivers of the public moneys, in cases where the indebtedness accrued prior to the year 1866.

Senate bill entitled an Act to aid in the establishment of a Hospital in connection with the Washington University of Baltimore, and to appropriate money for the same.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January session, 1867, chap 372, entitled an Act to further extend the time and provisions of an Act passed January 6th, chapter 15, and March 4th, 1864, chapter 373, and the supplements thereto, relating to the payments of bounties to volunteers and drafted men of this State.
