The bill was then sent to the House of Delegates.

On motion by Mr. Welch,

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow, at 11, A. M.

TUESDAY, March 3, 1868.

The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Prayer by the Rev. Mr. Miller.

Which was referred to the Senators from Worcester, Somerset and Wicomico.

Leave was granted to the Senators from Somerset, Wicomico and Worcester to report a bill entitled a supplement to the Act of 1864, chapter 116, entitled an Act to revive and extend an Act to incorporate the Wicomico and Pocomoke Railroad Company, with amendment passed at the December session, 1847.

On motion by Mr. Welch,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Education to introduce a bill entitled a supplement to an Act entitled an Act for founding a college at Chestertown, Kent county.

Senate bill entitled an Act to empower the Chesnut Hill Iron Ore Company, of Columbia, Pennsylvania, to hold lands in the State of Maryland.
