House bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Chancery," to come in after section 78 of said Article.

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Inspections.

House bill entitled an Act to add to Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset county, entitled "Jurors," an additional section.

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

House bill entitled an Act to protect oysters in Honga and Nanticoke Rivers, during the summer months.
