And returned to the House of Delegates.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 26, of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the fees of Registers of Wills, and re-enact the same with amendments,

Was taken up on its third reading.

Mr. Miller offered the following amendment:

Strike out the words "two cents," in 61st line of section 1, after the words pro rata, and insert "one cent and a half."

Which was adopted.

Pending the consideration of the bill,

On motion by Mr. Henkle,

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow at 11 o'clock, A. M.
