Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Calvert county to subscribe in behalf of said county to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Point Rail Road Company, and to issue bonds for that purpose,

Senate bill entitled an Act to appoint a Visitor to the Maryland Hospital for Wicomico county,
