Amend same section by adding after the word "tree," in

the 8th line, the words "or destroy any."

Amend section 1, line 10, by inserting after the word "thereof," the words "presentment, indictment and conviction thereof, in any Court of this State."

Amend section 1, line 13, by striking out the words "or Justice of the Peace."

Which were adopted,

And the bill as amended,

Read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
