Leave was granted to the Senators from Dorchester, Somerset and Caroline, to introduce a bill to add a sub-section to Public Local Laws of Dorchester county, Article 10, relating to roads.

Senate bill entitled an Act for the relief of James S. Morsell, Jr., of Calvert county,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill relating to the Registration of Voters of the State,

Was considered,

House bill entitled an Act to protect clams and shell fish in Worcester county,

Was taken up, and

Mr. Hyland offered the following amendments:

Strike out section 11, and insert the following in lieu thereof.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That the taking and carrying away oysters, which shall have been culled and laid out or bedded in any of the waters of this county, with a felonious intent to convert the same to his own use, shall be deemed a felony, and every person guilty of the same, upon conviction in a Court of competent jurisdiction shall be deemed guilty of felony, and be sentenced to the penitentiary for not less than two years nor more than five years.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
