titled an Act to provide by law for taking and perpetuating the evidence of the number of persons held to labor and service in the State of Maryland and emancipated by the Constitution, adopted in the year 1864, and by whom such persons were so held, passed March 22d, 1867, and substitute in lieu thereof the following section.

Which was read the second time.

Senate bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to the Public Local Laws of Dorchester county, Article 10, entitled Dorchester county,

Senate bill entitled an Act to refund to James Ensor, of Baltimore city, the sum of fifty dollars erroneously paid into the Treasury of the State,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 44, 45, and 46 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Prince George's County, under head of Collectors, and sections 47, 48 and 49 additional sections to said Article under same head, enacted by Act of 1864, chapter 326, and to reenact the same with amendments and additions,

Was read a third time and passed by year and nays as follows:
