Section 7, add, that if the fees of said inspector exceed \$2,500 per annum, the excess shall be paid over to the State Treasurer, in accordance with the provisions of the 15th Article of the Constitution.

Add to section 8 the following:

The said Inspector shall be appointed by the Superintendent of Labor and Agriculture, and shall give his bond in the penal sum of \$10,000, with security or securities, to be approved by said Superintendent, which bond shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Appeals.

Which were adopted, and

The bill, as amended, read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, 166, 167, 168, 169, 170, 171, 172, 173, 174, 175, 176, 177, 178, 179, 180, 181, 182, 183, 184, 185, 186, 187, 188, 189, 190, 191, and 192 of Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, sub-title Schools, and sections 158, 159, 160, and 161 of Article 3 of the supplement to the Code of Public Local Laws, sub-title Schools, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Was read a second time, and ordered to been grossed for a third reading.
