Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to open West Fayette Street, extending into Baltimore county,

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Allegany county, to improve a road running from Green Ridge on the National Turnpike to Twiggs Lock, on the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 23 of the 1st Article of the Code of Public Local Laws and re-enact the same with amendments,
