Title.

Sec. 568. All titles to property of any and every kind now held by the Visitors of the Jail of Baltimore City shall be, and they are hereby transferred to and vested in the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to all intents and purposes, and all powers and privileges heretofore conferred upon the said Visitors of the Jail of Baltimore City shall be, and they are hereby conferred upon the Mayor and City Council aforesaid.

Sec. 569. Each Visitor so appointed shall, before he proceeds to act, take and subscribe before the Mayor the oath of office prescribed in the sixth Section of the first Article of the Constitution.

Take effect.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that the said Mayor shall immediately appoint Visitors as in the case of vacancy under the existing laws and ordinances.
