issue from time to time, as they may deem proper, the Bonds of said Mayor and City Council, payable at such time and for such sums as they may deem proper, not exceeding the sum of fifty thousand dollars in any one year, and in the whole not exceeding the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, for the improvement of the Public Parks of the said city, the authority now given being that required by the seventh Section of Article eleven of the Constitution of this State, to enable the said Mayor and City Council to make appropriation at their discretion within the above limits for the purpose aforesaid.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT entitled "A Supplement to the Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland at January Session, eighteen hundred and sixty, entitled 'An Act to incorporate a Company to build a turnpike road from Libertytown, in Frederick County, to intersect the Woodsborough and Frederick Turnpike Road at or near the Monocacy Bridge,' and its Supplement passed at January Session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, of the General Assembly of Maryland, Chapter 230."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Managers of said Company, elected pursuant to the provisions of the Supplemental Act of January Session, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter 230, and their successors in office, shall have the power and authority to build and construct the turnpike road from its
