Sec. 17. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to confer the privilege of issuing any scrip or evidence of debt to be used as currency. No banking powers.

Sec. 18. *And be it enacted*, That a majority, in the amount of the whole number of stockholders, may, in their discretion, accept and exercise any additional powers and privileges which may at any time be conferred upon this Company, either by amendments of this Act or by any other Act hereinafter passed. Additional powers and privileges.

Sec. 19. *And be it enacted*, That in case of partial destruction by fire, the loss shall be determined by assessors to be appointed as follows: the person whose property is insured shall have the privilege of selecting one disinterested person and in ten days thereafter the Board of Directors of this Company shall select another, and in case of neglect or refusal of said President and Board of Directors to appoint such assessor within thirty days thereafter, then the person whose property has been injured, shall be authorized to appoint both assessors; should these two persons disagree in their valuation of the loss, they shall select another disinterested person, and the award of a majority shall be final, and the Company shall pay the same within ninety days after the date of the award. Losses—how paid.

Sec. 20. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall continue and be in force until the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and until the end of the next session of the General Assembly which shall take place thereafter. Limit.

Sec. 21. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act at pleasure. Reservation.

Sec. 23. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.
