Also.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Education to introduce a bill to authorize the Governor of the State of Maryland to purchase of the city of Baltimore the property known as the Baltimore City College, for the use of the State Normal School.

On motion of Mr. Deal,

Leave was granted to the Anne Arundel Delegation to report a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 194 of Article 8, of the Public Local Laws, entitled Anne Arundel county, sub-title Sheriff, and to re-enact another section in lieu thereof relating to fees of Sheriff, for keeping and boarding prisoners.

On motion of Mr. Bond of Baltimore city,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to amend an Act entitled, an Act to add a new section to Article 10, of the Code of Public General Laws entitled, "Attachments."

On motion of Mr. Mullin,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to repeal Sec. 58, of Art. 16, of the Code of Public General Laws under the title of Chancery Jurisdiction, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Devecmon,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section 202 of the 30th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, and reenact the same with amendments.
