

condition and repair for travel, nor in any event until said Turnpike Road is fully completed to the village of Reisterstown; and the question of declaring a dividend shall be determined by the stockholders at large at the annual meeting in January for the election of officers, at which meeting a full statement shall be exhibited of the finances of the said Company, which shall be submitted to the examination of a committee of the stockholders, whose report and action of the meeting thereof shall be recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose and shall be published once in some county paper.

Full statement.

Sec. 10. *And be it enacted*, That as soon as fifteen thousand dollars of the capital stock of said Company shall have been subscribed by private stockholders, the County Commissioners of Baltimore County are hereby authorized, subject to the provisions of Article third, Section fifty-four of the Constitution of Maryland, to subscribe, on behalf of said County, such an amount of money that six per cent. thereof shall equal the average yearly sum expended during the last four years by the said Commissioners upon the said road or roads upon the bed or beds of which said Western Run and Reisterstown Turnpike is built from the point of its departure from the Western Run Turnpike to its termination at Reisterstown to the capital stock of said Company and to levy the same upon.

Sec. 11. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and the General Assembly of Maryland reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at pleasure.
