

the same and with wheels four inches or upwards, three cents ; mules and oxen to be rated as horses.

Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That during the construction of said road the Company may obstruct the trade upon the same, so far as in their judgment may be necessary to protect it from injury. Obstruct trade.

Sec. 8. *And be it enacted*, That nothing in this Act shall be construed so as to authorize said Company to issue any note, token, scrip, device or other evidence of debt to be used as a currency, and the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter or amend this Act of incorporation at pleasure. Banking prohibited. Alter.

Sec. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT to amend the Code of Public General Laws, "Title Publication of Laws," by adding thereto an additional Section as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Article of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Publication of Laws," being the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, Chapter thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto an additional Section, as follows : Publication of laws.

5. The Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, shall pay to the publishers of the newspapers in which the Public General Laws are printed in conformity with the first Section of this Article, the compensation to which they may respectively be entitled for printing said General Laws, within six months from the time of publication.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.
