

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* ^{Levy tax.} That the levy of the State tax made by the County Commissioners of Allegany County, for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, of twelve cents on the one hundred dollars, on the basis of the assessment of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, instead of twenty cents on the one hundred dollars on the basis of the assessment of eighteen hundred and fifty-two, be and the same is hereby made valid and binding to all intents and purposes.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* ^{Repealed and in force.} That all other Acts heretofore passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, inconsistent with this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed and declared inoperative so far as Allegany County is concerned. And that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT to repeal Sections forty-six and forty-seven of the Code of Public Local Laws for Somerset County, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* ^{Repealed and re-enacted.} That Sections forty-six and forty-seven of the Code of Public Local Laws for Somerset County, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

Sec. 46. Somerset County is divided into nine ^{Districts.} Election Districts according to their present bounds and limits, except Princess Anne District, which shall hereafter, in addition to its former limits, include all that portion of the Trappe District remaining in Somerset County since the formation of Wicomico County, and the said Districts
